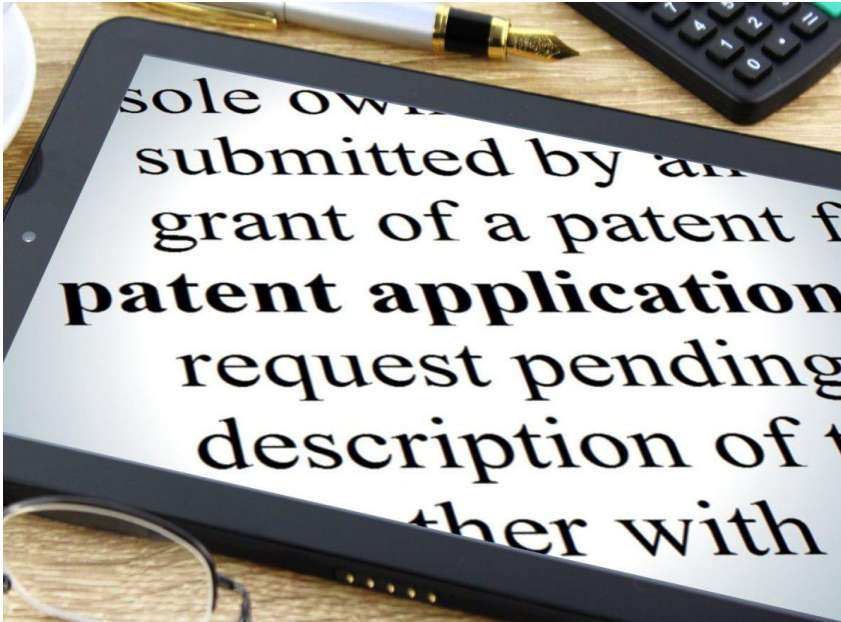

Due dates: Applications are accepted starting in January. They must be received by March 1, and decisions are announced in April.

Eligible organizations: within geographic areas Dominion provides electricity or natural gas service, or has significant facilities or business interests (see website)
